


IIPA Annual Debate-2024 Rules & Regulations

1. The debate will be conducted in the English language only.
2. Participants must be bona-fide students of the participating institution, enrolled in undergraduate or postgraduate courses of study.
3. Each participating University/Campus/College/Department/Institute is entitled to send only one team of two speakers: one speaking FOR and another speaking AGAINST the motion.
4. The best five speakers will be awarded cash prizes and merir certificates.
5. The IIPA Rolling Trophy will be awarded to the best team based on the combined scores of both participants.
6. All participants will receive a certificate of participation.
7. Each speaker will be allowed to speak for 5+1 minutes only (minimum time limit 5 minutes, maximum time limit 6 minutes). Negative marks will be given to those who exceed or fall below the time limit.
8. A jury consisting of three judges will evaluate the speaker's performance based on the following criteria:

a	Matter/Content	logical reasoning and content presented by the speaker.	50 marks
b	Manner/Style	Voice modulation (including suitable use of accents), presentation, delivery, and style	50 marks
c	Method/Strategy	structure and organization of speeches	50 marks

9. The verdict of the judges will be final and binding upon all. No protests or objections regarding the decision or the procedure will be entertained.
10. Admission to the debate will be subject to the presentation of a letter of credentials from the head of the institution certifying the bona-fide status of the participants. Identity cards with photographs signed by the appropriate authorities of the respective Institutions/Departments/Colleges should also be carried by the participants.
11. The speaking order of the participating teams shall be decided based on a draw of lots.
12. Participants may be accompanied by a teacher-in-charge and 4 to 5 students to support their team during the debate.
13. Paper reading will not be entertained in any case.
14. Registration is on a first-come, first-serve basis, subject to the availability of seats
