Rules and Regulations for KU Annual Shaan-e-Ramadhan Fest 2025 March 25–26, 2025

Organized by:

Division of youth Affairs Department of Students' Welfare, University of Kashmir

The following rules and regulations apply to each competition under the **KU Annual Shaan-e-Ramadhan Fest 2025**. All participants are expected to adhere to these guidelines to ensure fair and smooth conduct of the events.

1. Qirat Competition (Quran Recitation)

Eligibility:

- Open to all students from participating universities and colleges.
- Only one participation is allowed from each department / institution

Rules

- Participants must recite verses from the Holy Quran with proper **Tajweed (pronunciation rules)**.
- Each participant will be given 3–4 minutes for recitation.
- Marks will be awarded based on:
 - Pronunciation and articulation (Tajweed)
 - Melody and voice control
 - Fluency and confidence
- Any **mispronunciation** affecting the meaning of the verse may lead to disqualification.

Judging Criteria:

- 1. Tajweed & Pronunciation 40%
- 2. Voice & Melody 30%
- 3. Confidence & Presentation 20%
- 4. Overall Impact 10%

2. Naat Competition (Praise of the Prophet SAW)

Eligibility:

- Open to students from all participating institutions.
- Only one participation is allowed from each department / institution

Rules:

- Each participant will have **4–5 minutes** to present their Naat.
- Participants may recite in **Urdu**, **Arabic**, **Persian**, **or Kashmiri**.
- Use of background music or instruments is not allowed.
- The Naat should be respectful, meaningful, and praise the Holy Prophet Muhammad (SAW)
- Participants must avoid political or controversial themes.
- Judges' decisions will be final and binding.

Judging Criteria:

- 1. **Pronunciation & Clarity** 30%
- 2. Melody & Voice Quality 30%
- 3. Expression & Presentation 20%
- 4. Overall Impact 20%

3. Islamic Calligraphy Competition

Eligibility:

- Open to all students from participating institutions.
- Only one best participant is allowed from each department / institution

Rules:

- Each participant will be given **2 hours** to complete their artwork.
- Participants must bring their own calligraphy tools (pens, ink, brushes, etc.).
- Only Arabic/Islamic calligraphy will be accepted.
- The content must be Islamic verses, Hadith, or religious phrases
- Any form of offensive or inappropriate content will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Judges' decisions will be final.

Judging Criteria:

- 1. Creativity & Originality 30%
- 2. Aesthetic Appeal & Neatness 25%
- 3. Accuracy & Legibility 25%
- 4. Overall Presentation 20%

4 . Contemporary Calligraphy Competition

Eligibility:

- Open to all students from participating institutions.
- Only one best participant is allowed from each department / institution

Rules:

- The painting should depict Islamic themes in the Contemporary Calligraphy Competition
- Participants must bring their own painting materials (colors, brushes, canvas, etc.).
- The artwork must be original and should not violate any religious or cultural sensitivities.
- The time limit is 2 hours.
- Plagiarism or copying from the internet will lead to disqualification.
- Judges' decisions will be final.

Judging Criteria:

- 1. Creativity & Theme Representation 30%
- 2. Color Harmony & Detailing 25%
- 3. **Technique & Skill** 25%
- 4. Overall Impact & Aesthetic Appeal 20%

General Rules for All Competitions:

Registration is mandatory and must be completed by March 20, 2025. Each participant must carry a **valid student ID card**. Participants should report **30 minutes before** the start of their event. Any kind of **misconduct, plagiarism, or indiscipline** will result in **disqualification**. **Judges' decisions will be final and binding**.
